Notification

No. C/2700 Jabalpur, dated 09th June, 2022

The Clause No. 16 of the Standard Operating Procedure No. 05/PRJ/2022, dated 11.02.2022, reads as follows;

“(16) Wearing of gowns by the Advocates appearing before the High Court shall for the time being remain exempted. However, it shall be necessary for the Advocates to wear the Coat and Band.”

The Honourable Special Committee, constituted to oversee the matters relating to physical or virtual functioning of the High Court as well as District Courts has unanimously passed a resolution to delete above mentioned Clause No. 16 and to request the learned Advocates to wear full attire including gown with effect from 13.6.2022.

As a result whereof, learned Advocates are requested to wear the full attire including gown with effect from 13.6.2022.
